White Cane Clinic

On Saturday, August 25th from 9:00 AM- 12:00 PM, the center will be holding a White Cane Clinic. This FREE clinic will be led by Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialists and is for people and families of people who are visually impaired and need a long white cane and/or beginning cane training. While there is no minimum age requirement, participants *cannot be eligible to receive services through the state of Illinois*. This is an intensive, active-learning clinic, which will be offered if we have five people register but can accommodate a maximum of ten. Family members are strongly encouraged to join so they can help support at home and in the community.

The clinic will cover basic and advanced human guide, which is proper technique for guiding a blind or visually impaired person, how to manipulate the long white cane in a variety of situations, and basic cane technique to navigate your environment (e.g., up and down stairs, around the block, etc.). We want to emphasize once again that family members are encouraged to join; we ask that if you are bringing a family member that they transport you to and from the clinic. For those who are attending solo, the Center will provide transportation if you need it within a 15-mile radius of the Center.
