FOOD BASKET DELIVERY UPDATE

We are happy to be able to personally deliver food baskets to our patrons who need them, but we also ask that recipients follow a few basic guidelines:

- 1. Basket delivery dates are in the newsletter. If you do NOT want a basket that month you need to let us know AHEAD OF TIME not the day of delivery. We pack these baskets and they sometimes have perishable items in them so to go out for delivery only to have them refused means ruined food someone else could have used. Please be respectful of this if it happens two times in a row or three times in a year, you will be taken off the list.
- 2. The delivery containers get reused. Please return them in clean condition. A quick wipe down with anti-bacterial wipes work well and these wipes are periodically provided in your basket.
- 3. If you do not answer your phone, your basket will not be delivered. We can't leave it without a person there. If this happens two times in a row or three times in a year, you will be taken off the list.
